

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DESIGN A MARS ROCKET COMPETITION

It's easy to enter the Richer Education's Design a Mars Rocket competition ("the competition"). All the information below will help you prepare your entry.

These are the rules ("Official Rules"), which apply to the competition. If you do not comply with them, you may be disqualified without further notice.

- Entry is free and open to all 5 – 11 year old pupils attending state and independent primary schools in the UK, except employees of Richer Education, their families, contractors or associated companies
- All entries must be submitted online
- The submission text should be no more than 250 words in length
- You may not submit more than one entry per student
- The website is now open for entries until 23:59 on 20th March 2016
- All winners will be chosen by a judging committee chosen by Richer Education and notified accordingly
- No cash alternative for any prizes will be offered
- Richer Education will not share your personal details with any third parties
- The winner may be required to partake in media activity relating to the competition

How to Enter

- All entries must be completed and submitted by the participating student
- To win, the entrant must answer all the "Entry Questions" (photos and/or posters will not be considered if sent without answers to the entry questions)
- You can enter online by completing the registration process outlined on the Richer Education Competition Website. However, Richer Education will be under no obligation to send a confirmation email acknowledging receipt of any entry.
- Entries to the Competition can be submitted at any time from 22nd February 2016 until 23:59 GMT on 20th March 2016
- All entries will become the property of Richer Education upon receiving and will not be returned. Entrants hereby assign to Richer Education's Terms and Conditions.

The Prizes

- Entrants to the competition will be judged on a separate basis according to which Key Stage they are in at Primary School. For example: Key Stage One, Key Stage Two or Key Stage Three
 - Each key stage will receive a first prize and a runner up prize
 - The first prize, per Key Stage, will be a place on Richer Education's four day Easter camp (The Easter camp will take place from Tuesday 29th March 2016 until Friday 1st April 2016 inclusive. All sessions will take place at Imperial College London. Exhibition Road. SW7 2AZ. Sessions start at 9:00am and will finish at 3:30pm).
 - Each runner up, per Key Stage, will win a place on a set of four Saturday Science workshops (Saturdays should be booked in advance. Booking sessions beforehand is compulsory. All sessions will take place at Imperial College London. Exhibition Road. SW7 2AZ. Sessions start at 9:30am and will finish at 11:30am).
